
2021-2022(November-May)

(a) Name of the Programme: Entrepreneurship Development (Duration - 30 Hours)

(b) Number of Student Enrolled: 8

(c) Curriculum Assessment Procedure: The department of Economics has chosen "Entrepreneurship Development" as an Add-on course for the students to be enrolled and assess the course in three different ways-

- (i) There will be continuous assessment or evaluation through question answering and discussions among the students and faculty members.
- (ii) At the end of the course written examinations of 40 marks will be held among the students covering all the units of the syllabus.
- (iii) Students will have to submit a field study report as per the syllabus covering 10 marks and they will be guided by the faculty members by visiting industry/firm or by giving a lecture by renowned entrepreneur or industrialist.

3. Summary Report of the Programme: The department of Economics Kamarbandha

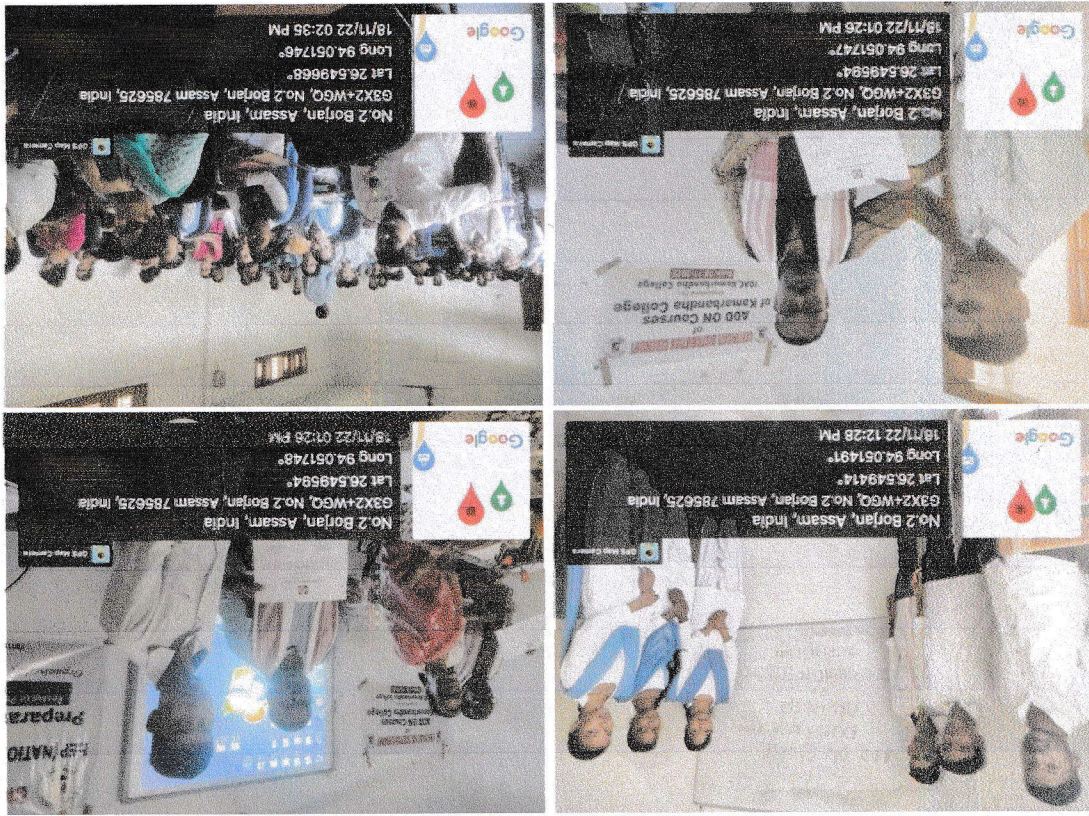
College conducted an Add on Course on "Entrepreneurship Development" from 8th September, 2022 to 14th November, 2022. It is a course about to discover decision making techniques to run own business. This course may help to learn about how to become a successful entrepreneur or businessman in the real world. It is quite impossible to have a public job after having completed the formal education. Therefore, a large number of educated youth will remain unemployed and it is only this course that can train up them for being self employed by absorbing them in different types of business activities or starting different scale of industries/enterprises of his/her own.

An entrepreneurship education also teaches students the underlying principles of starting a business, how to avoid common pitfalls, pitch ideas more effectively, validate products, develop a solid business model and set everybody up for success in a field where failure is common. Besides the theoretical knowledge this course also include the practical knowledge by visiting the areas of industrial or business importance, conducting field study, and by listening to lectures of resource persons who are well established in the field of business or industries. It can be well mentioned here that kamarbandha College has started an incubation centre for entrepreneurship development under the guide ship of "Research, Extension and Innovation Cell". This Cell will arrange seminar, workshop etc. for the purpose of such entrepreneurship development.

A total of 8 students took admission for the course. Starting from 8th September, 2022 there were 30 sessions (each with one hour) of classes conducted by faculty members of Economics department. The sessions were divided into two categories- (1) Preparation of mind set of the student for acquiring theoretical knowledge of entrepreneurship development as per the syllabus.

(2) Conducting field study in the area of business and industrial importance or attending to workshop arranged by the department in this field. After the successful completion of the course a written examination of 40 marks was held among the students with 20 MCQs. After proper assessment of their question answer scripts six students were awarded certificate with Grade-A and the other two students got certificate with Grade-B for their poor performance. A certificate distribution ceremony was arranged by the Coordinator of IQAC of the college under the *chairman ship of the Principal Atul Saikia*. Two faculty members of Furkating College namely, Mrs. Indira Gogoi, present IQAC Coordinator and Associate Prof. of English and Dr. Munitril Hussain, Assistant Prof. of Dept. Sociology were invited as resource persons for the distribution ceremony. They delivered lectures addressing to the students and faculty members on the programme of the day and distributed certificate among the successful students. The distribution of certificate ceremony ended with a vote of thanks by the Debajyoti Goswami, the IQAC Coordinator, Kamarbandha College.

 4. Viva of 5 marks.

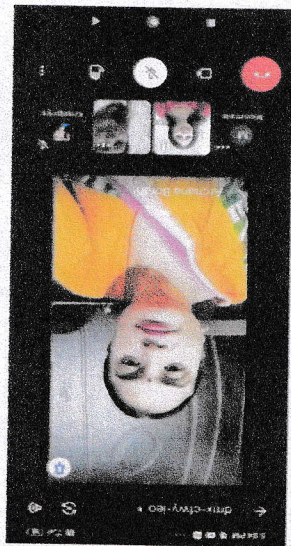

Summary Report

From the academic session 2022-23 as per the guideline of the DU with the help of "National Qualification Framework" The department of philosophy of Kamarbandha college is implementing "Cutting and Embroidery as Add-on course to provide the students knowledge of the skill enhancement course on Cutting and Hand Embroidery."

Objectives of the programme:

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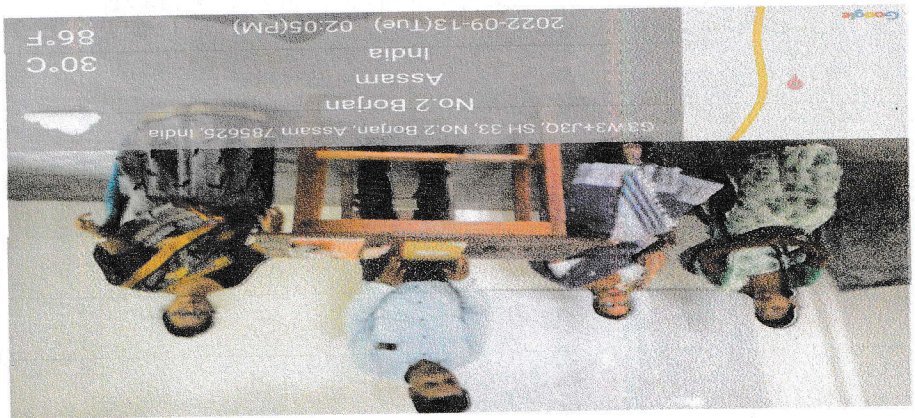

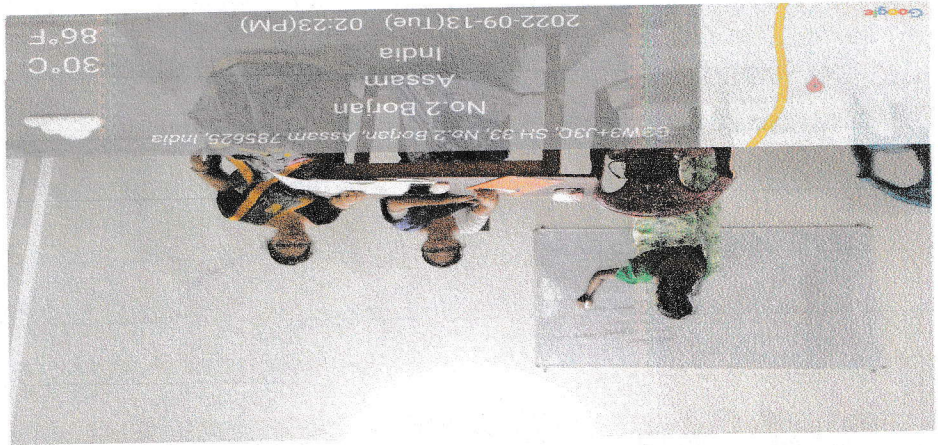

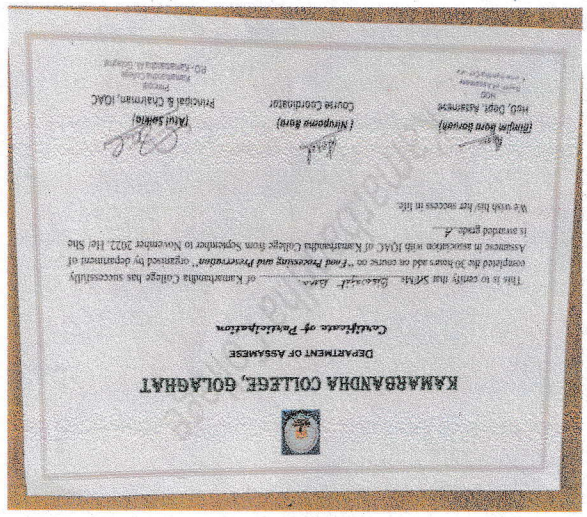
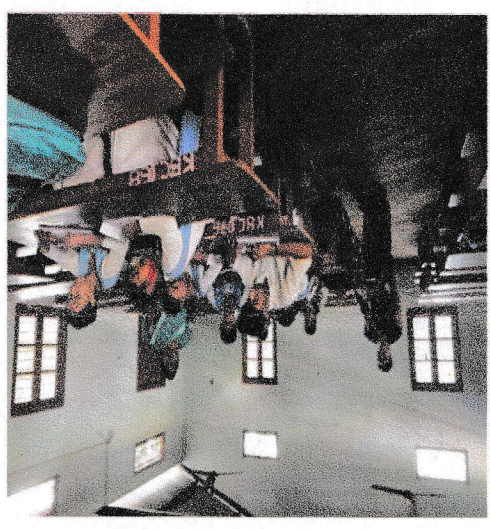


Figure 2 theory examination
