- An abstract should be written within 300 words including at least 4–5 keywords.
- The prescribed word limit for the full paper is **2500–3500 words**.
- Papers are to be written in either **English or Assamese**.
- The papers should have the latest **APA format** comprising the following:
 - Font: **Times New Roman** (MS Word)
 - Title of paper: **14 pts**, Font Size: **12 pts**, Justified, Line spacing: **1.5**
- For manuscript written in Assamese, **Ramdhenu software** for typing (Font style: **Gitanjali**, font size: **13.5**) can be used.
- All the accepted full-length papers will be published in an **edited book volume with ISBN number** at national level.
